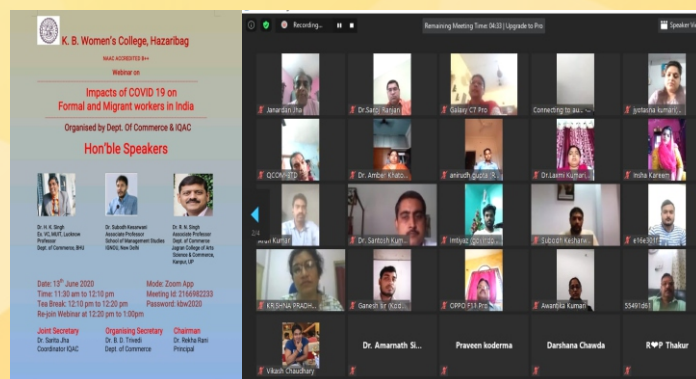

A Plantation Drive of Medicinal Plants was conducted by the Department of Botany.



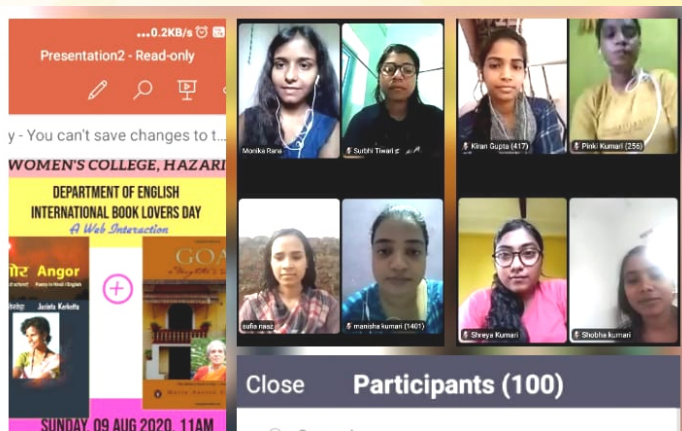
COMMERCE

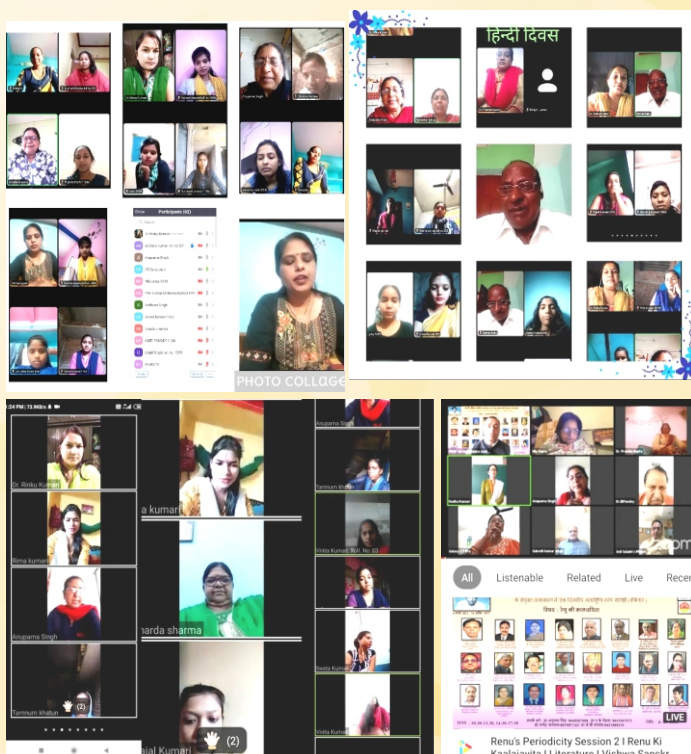
ENGLISH

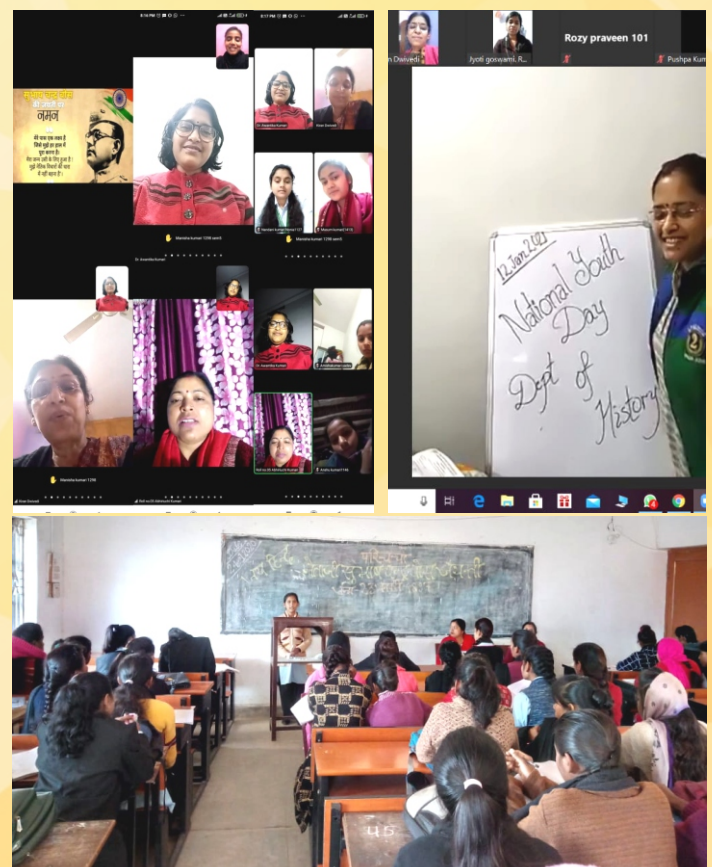
GEOGRAPHY

The Department of Political Science organised online discussion to celebrate 'Gandhi Jayanti' & 'Human Rights Day' for the students.



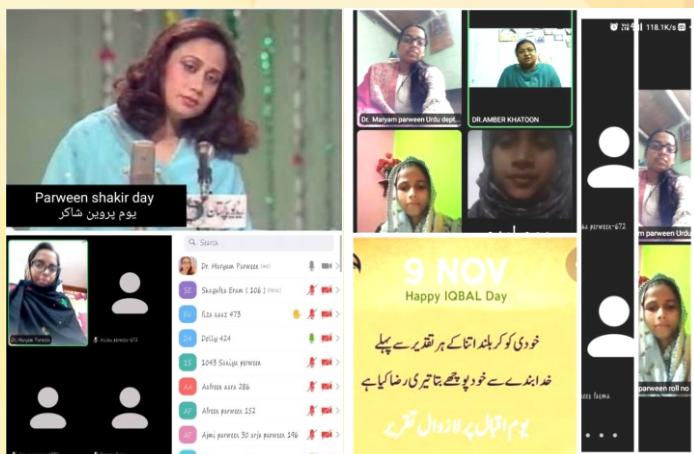
BCS

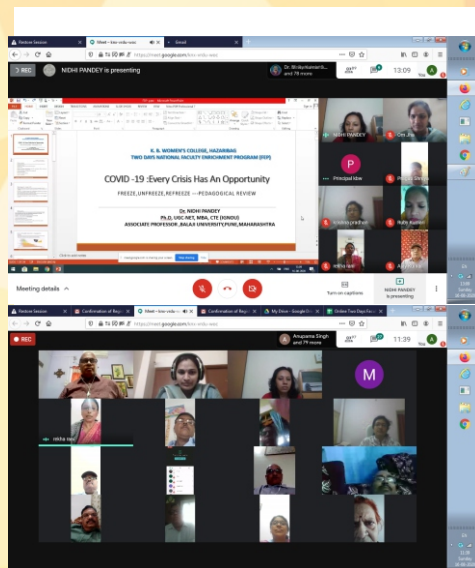

NATIONAL FACULTY ENRICHMENT PROGRAM (FEP) ON "HIGHER EDUCATION WITH COVID -19: CHALLENGES & PROSPECTS"

A Two-Day Online National Faculty Enrichment Programme (FEP) on "Higher Education with COVID -19: Challenges & Prospects" was successfully conducted by IQAC during 16 & 17 August 2020. The FEP received an overwhelming response with 180 participants from India and abroad. In her welcome address, Dr. Rekha Rani, the Principal of our college, emphasised that the crisis has brought an opportunity for teachers and learners to become more empowered, creative, and innovative through digital mode.

Resource Person, **Prof. K. N. Jena**, Prof in Political Science and Controller of Examinations, Tripura University (A Central University), discussed that the current COVID-19 situation is not an excuse to stop continuous learning, and thus digital education must be central to an institution's teaching-learning strategy. Dr. Nidhi Pandey, Associate Professor, Balaji University, Pune, Maharashtra, highlighted that online teaching in this hard time has opened new avenues for educational institutions to integrate technology in traditional education.



Dr. Sudhanshu Kumar Jha, Assistant Professor (CSE), Dept. of Electronics & Communication, Faculty of Science, University of Allahabad, U.P., discussed ICT is a great enabler and facilitator of online learning that keeps the learning process intact even at this time of crisis. His hands-on session on using Google Form made the program interesting for the participants. **Dr. B. M. Pandey**, Head Department of Law, Tripura University (Central University), highlighted on the accessibility of reliable and stable internet connection remains an ongoing challenge for e-learning. It is high time to find out how to cope with current demand and to improve its connectivity in the long term.
